



## **INTRODUCTION**

The objective of this document is to summarise sources of published information on the distribution of vertebrate wildlife (birds, mammals, reptiles and amphibians) in Victoria. Two major sources of published information are described.

- (i) Publications which provide state-wide distributional information, and summaries of the biology of species, for various faunal groups.
- (ii) Scientific literature, published in books, journals and reports, which provides information on the occurrence and distribution of one or more species in Victoria. These references form the majority of the bibliography presented here.

This bibliography complements the computer-based Atlas of Victorian Wildlife, that has recently been developed by the Wildlife Management Branch. The Atlas of Victorian Wildlife is a computer data base of locality records of vertebrate species in Victoria, that can be rapidly accessed to obtain data on species' distributions within defined areas of the state.

Records in the Atlas have been collated from a wide range of sources including: fauna surveys conducted by the Wildlife Management Branch since 1972; specimen records from the Museum of Victoria; fauna surveys conducted by educational institutions and field naturalists clubs; and records submitted by interested people. The Atlas data base includes more than 800,000 records of birds, and more than 40,000 records of mammals. Records of reptiles and amphibians have only begun to be entered, and coverage is patchy at present.

Procedures for requesting data from, or submitting data to, the Atlas are set out in 'The Atlas of Victorian Wildlife Users Manual', available from the Wildlife Management Branch, Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands.

### **Acknowledgements**

This bibliography was compiled using DBASE 3 programmes written by Brad Dale and Simon Bennett. Numerous staff of the Wildlife Management Branch commented on a draft document, and provided both editorial suggestions and additional references.

## **GENERAL REFERENCES ON THE DISTRIBUTION AND BIOLOGY OF WILDLIFE IN VICTORIA**

The publications listed below provide information on the state-wide distribution of wildlife species in Victoria, and/or aspects of species' biology. The distributional maps that are presented in these publications may be consulted to gain an overall perspective of the distribution of each species in Victoria.

Biological attributes such as habitat preferences, population density, size of home range, and diet, are important influences on the way a species is distributed in the environment. A basic knowledge of such attributes is an essential foundation for wildlife management. Several of the sources listed below provide a general summary of species biology and suggest further references that may be consulted for additional information.

In general, references have been included if they:


- (i) provide data on the occurrence of a number of species at a site, particularly if they describe results of a wildlife survey. Inclusion of references to lists of birds has had to be selective because of the enormous number of reports in the literature. In an attempt to assess these references, those which describe a reasonably comprehensive survey have been referenced as BIRDS-SURVEY, while those which appear to be more casual lists are referenced as BIRDS-LIST. Even so, many lists have not been included.
- (ii) provide data on the state-wide distribution or status of a single species, particularly those that are rare, or of vulnerable status. Brief reports, or single sightings of species, generally have not been included: these records will be incorporated in publications such as the Atlas of Victorian Birds, or in the computer data bases of the Atlas of Victorian Wildlife of the National Parks and Wildlife Division.

Several additional sources, which have not been searched for references, may also have important distributional records for a particular area under consideration.

These sources include newsletters and magazines produced by Field Naturalists Clubs (e.g. 'Whirrakee' by Bendigo Field Naturalists Club, or 'Sunraysia Naturalist'), and by special interest groups (e.g. Australasian Raptor Association Newsletter, 'The Stilt' by Australian Wader Studies Group). The 'Bird Observer', the monthly newsletter of the Bird Observers Club of Australia, contains many notes on the occurrence of birds, with the regular feature 'Unusual Sightings' being of particular interest for unusual or interesting distributional records.

References within the bibliography are numbered and listed alphabetically by author, with full details of title and publication. In the following section the reference numbers of sources of distributional data are listed for geographical areas corresponding to the regional boundaries of the Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands (Fig. 1.). For each region, references are indexed by faunal groups (BIRDS, MAMMALS, REPTILES and AMPHIBIANS).

References concerning birds and mammals have been further classified when only a limited group of species are discussed. For example; MAMMALS-BATS indicates references which present information only on bats. References which discuss bats, together with other mammals from a locality, are indexed as MAMMALS-GENERAL. Similarly, BIRDS-SPECIES indicates references which present information on only a single species of bird. References which discuss this species together with other birds from a locality are generally indexed as either BIRDS-SURVEY or BIRDS-LIST.
