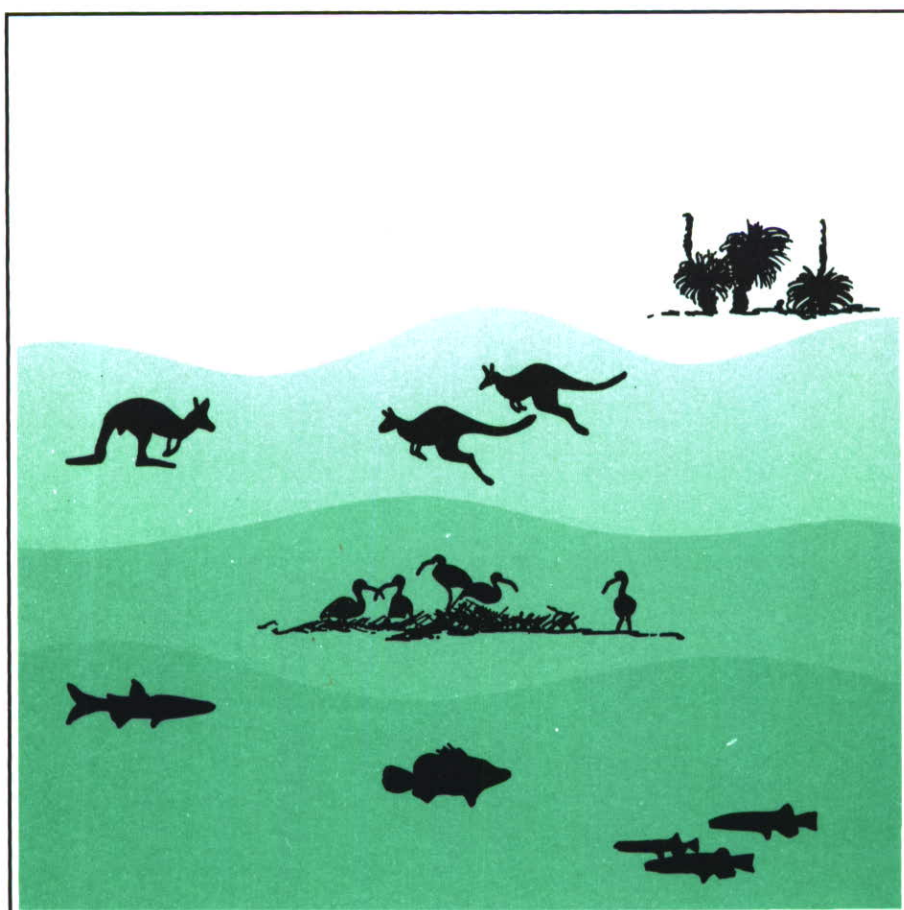

FLORA AND FAUNA BRANCH—LIST OF PUBLICATIONS 1990–2

The Flora and Fauna Division was created in September, 1990 and evolved to the Flora and Fauna Branch in 1992. It comprises four sections, Sub-program Co-ordination, Wildlife, Flora and Freshwater Ecology Sections. Since the Branch has now been operational for two years and publications are no longer listed in the Department's Annual Report, this list has been compiled to document the Branch's published outputs and to provide ready access to them for the public.

SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Scientific Advisory Committee, set up under the *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act* 1988, is an independent committee that advises the Minister on listings under the Act and other conservation matters.
